
### Luggage

# LOCATION

The Grafton Arms is located at 72 Grafton Way just a few minutes walk from Warren Street station (Victoria line); a 6 minute walk to Great Portland Street station (Hammersmith & City, Circle and Metropolitan line) and a 7 minute walk to Goodge Street station (Northern line). Tottenham Court Road station (Central & Norther Line) is 6 minute walk.



## LOCAL ATTRACTIONS

Fitzrovia is a diverse residential area where grand 18th- and 19th-century apartments sit side by side with social housing. Handy for the West End theatres, galleries and old-school pubs. Charlotte Street is lined with lively bistros and cafes. The quiet streets are also home to new media, advertising and architectural companies. The lofty BTTower is an iconic city landmark.

#### The New Diorama Theatre

The New Diorama Theatre is an 80-seat performance space located in central London, close to Great Portland Street, dedicated to presenting the work of theatre companies from straight theatre to comedy and opera.

## The Magic Circle

The purpose built headquarters of The Magic Circle in Euston houses a vast collection of posters and memorabilia relating to the history of mystery. The building also includes a museum, located on the lower ground floor, a treasure trove of items from the golden age of music halls. Up on the third floor is The Magic Circle Theatre, a modern auditorium with fixed, tiered, seating for up to 126 delegates in the stalls and a further 36 seats in the balcony. Regular public events include 'At Home with The Magic Circle' evenings when visitors are treated to performances by The Magic Circle's top magicians.

## Fitzroy Square

Fitzroy Square is one of London's finest squares and the only London square designed by Robert Adam. It is named after Charles Fitzroy, 4th Duke of Grafton and, in turn, gives its name to the surrounding area known as Fitzrovia. The circular garden in the centre is surrounded by historic buildings including the London Foot Hospital as well as the houses designed by Adam in the late 18th century - No. 33 was Adam's last building project and, as the home of Roger Fry's Omega Workshops, has close links with the Bloomsbury Group. The concentration of blue plaques adorning the houses on the square identify its famous past residents including Victorian Prime Minister Lord Salisbury and writers George Bernard Shaw and Virginia Woolf, who both lived at No. 29 at different times.

#### The British Museum

# SHOPPING

#### Oxford Street

Oxford Street is a major road in the City of Westminster in the West End of London, running from Marble Arch to Tottenham Court Road via Oxford Circus. It is Europe's busiest shopping street, with around half a million daily visitors, and as of 2012 had approximately 300 shops.

#### Covent Garden

Covent Garden is in the West End, London's main theatre and entertainme area. Tourists fill its elegant, car-free Piazza, home to fashion stores, crafts at the Apple Market and the Royal Opera House. Street entertainers perform by 17th-century St. Paul's Church, and the London Transport Museum houses vintage vehicles.






# FOURTH FLOOR




# THIRD FLOOR





### **GROUND FLOOR**



#### IF YOU DISCOVER, OR ACCIDENTALLY START A FIRE:

Leave the room immediately, ensuring that the door closes fully behind you.

Activate the nearest call point to sound the alarm (These are located on the landing)

#### IF YOU HEAR THE FIRE ALARM:

Leave the room immediately

Report to a member of staff

Exit the building via the stairs to the Entrance door.

Go to assembly point on corner of Grafton Way and Whitfield Street outside Cafe Rio.

If obvious signs of fire are observed, call 0207 627 0344 or diall 999

Do not re enter the building unless told to do so by an official.
